Advisory on Covid-19 related Evacuation Facilitation

This is in continuation to our Advisory dated 05th July, 2020 regarding next Badr flight expected to be organized by Sudanese authorities shortly to evacuate Sudanese nationals from New Delhi. Since the lock-down has now been lifted since 08th July and normal official work has started in various government offices, all the interested evacuees who have registered in response to our Advisory dated 05th July are hereby requested to get their travel documents in order like regularization of stay, expired visa, residential permits and police reporting from the concerned local authorities before buying tickets. Since lock-down has been lifted and normal work has begun in the government offices, the emergent situation under which the exit is stamped at the airport ignoring visa violations, etc., may not be applicable any more.

Therefore, it is informed to all the registered evacuees to get documents like visas, stay permits and police registration validated/updated before the scheduled departure to avoid any problems at the airport. Also, they should carry a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate.
